UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The present Special Leave Petition is for grant of regular bail as the petitioner is in jail in

connection with FIR No. 130 of 2025, registered at Police Station-Purkaji, District-Muzaffar Nagar, Uttar Pradesh, for the offence punishable under Sections 316(2), 316(5), 318(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. It has been stated that petitioner was acting as a collection agent of Bharat Finance India Limited and after collecting the amount, he has not deposited the same with the Company.

3. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that the investigation is complete and he has cooperated with the investigation and the amount involved is Rs. 2,00,000/- only.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent-State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail.

5. This Court after careful consideration of the record and after hearing learned counsel for the parties, is of the opinion that the application for grant of bail deserves to be allowed and is accordingly allowed.

6. Accordingly, we direct that the petitioner be enlarged on bail in connection with abovementioned FIR, on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court, subject to the condition that the

petitioner shall continue to co-operate with the trial/investigation.

7. The Special Leave Petition is disposed of in the above terms.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
