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**CORRIGENDUM TO THE NOTICE OF POSTAL BALLOT**

The Notice of the Postal Ballot ("Postal Ballot Notice") of the Members of iSERA Lifesciences Limited (Formerly known as Covidh Technologies Limited) ("Company") was dispatched to the Members on Tuesday, April 21, 2026, in compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the rules made thereunder, read with the applicable circulars issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs and the Securities and Exchange Board of India. The e-voting in respect of the said Postal Ballot was conducted from Wednesday, April 22, 2026 to Thursday, May 21, 2026 (both days inclusive).

This Corrigendum to the Postal Ballot Notice ("**Corrigendum**") is being issued to make certain amendments and provide additional disclosures in the Explanatory Statement to Item No. 7 of the Postal Ballot Notice, as required under the SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 ("SEBI ICDR Regulations"), pursuant to queries raised by BSE Limited.

This Corrigendum shall form an integral part of the Postal Ballot Notice dated April 21, 2026 circulated to the Members of the Company. Accordingly, all concerned Members, BSE Limited, Depositories (NSDL and CDSL), Registrar and Share Transfer Agent, agencies appointed for e-voting, other authorities, regulators, and all other concerned persons are requested to take note of the changes set out herein. Except as detailed in this Corrigendum, all other disclosures in the Postal Ballot Notice dated April 21, 2026, along with its Explanatory Statement, shall remain unchanged.

**1. Amendment to sub-paragraph (g) of the Explanatory Statement to Item No. 7, Intent of the Promoters, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel or Senior Management to subscribe to the Preferential Offer:**

In the table appearing under sub-paragraph (a) of the Explanatory Statement to Item No. 7 of the Postal Ballot Notice, the entry against Sr. No. 7 (Dhairyasheel Vasantrya Yadav) reflected the number of equity shares to be allotted as "4,50,50". This was a typographical error. The said entry is hereby corrected as under:
