UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Before we proceed further on this petition, we deem it appropriate to ascertain whether the petitioner-company had, at any stage, questioned the order passed by the learned Magistrate dated 14.10.2014 either before the High Court or before the Sessions Court.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner had invited our attention to Annexure P-17 which is an order purportedly passed on a complaint filed by Yash Papers Limited. We fail to understand how Yash Papers Limited would be able to maintain a complaint under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

3. In such circumstances, the learned counsel for the petitioner shall file an additional affidavit bringing on record true and correct copies of the documents and also disclosing whether the petitioner had taken recourse to any proceedings either before the High Court or before the Sessions Court against the order of the learned Magistrate dated 14.10.2014.

4. For the said purpose, two weeks' time is granted.
