- The Board of Directors of the Company, in their meeting held on 06th September, 2024 approved a issuance of 82, 33,359 Convertible Warrants on Preferential basis, each convertible into 1 (one) Equity Shares of face value of Rs 10/- (Rupees Ten only) each fully paid up at a premium of Rs. 104/- per share ("the equity shares") i.e., 1 warrant converted into 1 equity shares of face value of Rs. 10/- each fully paid up at a premium of Rs. 104/- per share to proposed allottees, on preferential basis, upto an amount of Rs. 93,86,02,926.00 at a issuance price of Rs 114.00 per Warrants (derived pursuant to SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations. 2018). Shareholders of the Company, vide Resolution passed through notice postal Ballot dated 06th October, 2024 and receipt of in-principal approval letter dated December 19, 2024 from BSE & NSE LIMITED, approved the issuance of Convertible Warrants on preferential basis. During the quarter and year ended 31st March, 2025. The Company received an aggregate consideration of 15.95 Crores upto 31st March, 2026 towards minimum 25% of the total consideration of the Warrants. As on 31st March, 2026 total 18,94,331 warrants have been converted into equity shares.

Report on the Audit of the Standalone Financial Results

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying statement of audited Standalone financial results of **DJ Mediaprint & Logistics Limited** ("the Company") for the quarter year ended 31st March 2026 and the year to date results for the period from 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2026 ("the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations"), including relevant circulars issued by the SEBI from time to time.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid Statement:

- i. are presented in accordance with the requirements of the Listing Regulations in this regard; and
- ii. give a true and fair view in conformity with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the applicable Indian Accounting Standards ("Ind AS") specified under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act"), read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules 2015, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the net profit and other comprehensive income and other financial information for the quarter ended 31 March 2026 and the year to date results for the period from 1st April 2025 to 31st March 2026.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing ("SA") specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act"). Our responsibilities under those SAs are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Results section of our report. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements under the provisions of the Act and the rules thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion on the financial results.



Management's Responsibilities for the Financial Results

The Statement has been prepared on the basis of the annual financial statements and has been approved by the company's Board of Directors. The Company's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the Statement that give a true and fair view of the net profit/loss and other comprehensive income and other financial information of the company in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including Ind AS prescribed under section 133 of the Act, read with relevant rules issued there under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, and in compliance with Regulations 33 of the Listing Regulations.

This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding of the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Statement that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the Statement, the Board of Directors are responsible for assessing the Company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless the Board of Directors either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Board of Directors are also responsible for overseeing the Company's financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Results

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Statement is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Standard on Auditing (SAs), specified under section 143(10) of the Act, will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of the Statement.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- i. Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Statement, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.



- ii. Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances. Under Section 143(3)(i) of the Act, we are also responsible for expressing our opinion through a separate report on the complete set of financial statements on whether the Company has adequate internal financial controls with reference to financial statements in place and the operating effectiveness of such controls.
- iii. Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the Board of Directors.
- iv. Conclude on the appropriateness of the Board of Directors' use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the Company's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the Statement or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Company to cease to continue as a going concern.
- v. Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the Statement, including the disclosures, and whether the Statement represents the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

Materiality is the magnitude of misstatements in the financial statement that, individually or in aggregate, makes it probable that the economic decisions of a reasonably knowledgeable user of the financial statement may be influenced. We consider quantitative materiality and qualitative factors in (i) planning the scope of our audit work and in evaluating the results of our work; and (ii) to evaluate the effect of any identified misstatements in the financial statement.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.

Other Matter

Balances of Trade receivables, Trade Payables, Advance and deposits received/ given, from /to customers are subject to confirmations and subsequent reconciliation.

The Statement includes the results for the quarter ended 31st March, 2026 being the balancing figure between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year ended 31st March, 2026 and the published unaudited year-to-date figures up to the third quarter of the financial year, which were subjected to a limited review by us, as required under the Listing Regulations.

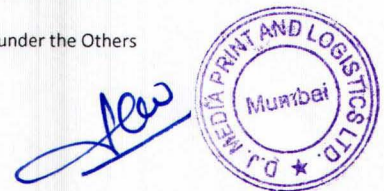

Basis for Opinion

2. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing ("SA") specified under section 143(10) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act"). Our responsibilities under those SAs are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Consolidated Financial Results section of our report. Our review report is not modified in respect of this matter.

3. The Statement has been prepared on the basis of the consolidated annual financial statements. The Company's Board of Directors are responsible for the preparation and presentation of the Statement that give a true and fair view of the consolidated net profit and loss and other comprehensive income and other financial information of the group in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in AS prescribed under Section 133 of the Act read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with the Listing Regulations. 4. 6.
