Opinion

We have audited the accompanying Statement of quarter and year to date Financial Results of **STALLION INDIA FLUOROCHEMICALS LIMITED** ('the Company') for the quarter ended and for the year ended 31st March, 2026 ('the statement'), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended.

1. The financial results are prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rule 2015 and amendments issued thereafter prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies as applicable.
2. These financial results were reviewed and recommended by the Audit Committee on 13th May, 2026 and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on 13th May, 2026.
3. The company's business falls within single business segment of manufacture of industrial gases. Hence, disclosures under Ind AS 108- Operating Segments are not reported separately.
4. The figures of the quarter ended March 31, 2026 and March 31, 2025 are the balancing figures between audited figures in respect of full financial year and the published year to date figures up to the end of the third quarter of the year.
5. The Company has received an amount of INR 14,673.95 lakhs (net of IPO expenses of INR 1,198.92 lakhs) from proceeds out of fresh issue of equity shares. The utilisation of net IPO proceeds is summarised below.

Net IPO Proceeds which were unutilized as at March 31, 2026 were temporarily invested in fixed deposits with Banks, Monitoring Agency Bank Account, IPO Public issue account and the company's current account.

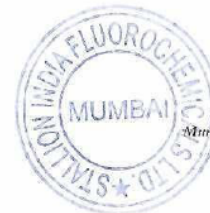
6. During the quarter and year ended March 31, 2026, the Board of Directors of Stallion India Fluorochemicals Limited had approved and completed a Rights Issue of Equity Shares in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013, the SEBI (Issue of Capital and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2018 and other applicable laws.

The Company offered 3,67,60,483 Equity Shares of face value of ₹10/- each to the eligible equity shareholders in the ratio of 19 Rights Equity Shares for every 41 fully paid-up Equity Shares held as on the record date i.e. February 11, 2026, at an issue price of ₹99/- per Rights Equity Share (including premium of ₹89/- per share).

The Rights Issue opened on February 20, 2026 and closed on February 27, 2026. Pursuant to allotment of the Rights Equity Shares on March 2, 2026, the Company raised an aggregate amount of approximately ₹363.93 Crores before issue related expenses.

7. Previous period figures have been regrouped, rearranged and reclassified where necessary to make it comparable with current period's classification.
