Heard Mr. Dhruv Mehta, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner/applicant and Ms.Rupali Francesca Samuel, learned counsel for the respondent-Sangh.

2. The matter relates to compliance of award passed in favour of the respondent-union with regard to 580 members. Certain payments were required to be made by the petitioner/applicant to them. However, out of 580 members, substantial payments have been made only to 326 members. With regard to the remaining members, the major stumbling block is that neither they themselves, nor their heirs/legal representatives are traceable, for which, various steps are being taken, but till now the exercise is not complete. It has further been agreed between the parties that they will try different modes to reach out to the remaining workers, for which, time is required. Minutes of meeting between the parties indicates that a deadline of 02.10.2026 has been fixed for completing the exercise.

3. Having regard to the aforesaid, we hope and expect that the petitioner/applicant is able to discharge its obligation/liability prior to the said date and report to the Court thereafter.

4. We note, by way of clarification, that the substantive

responsibility lies on the shoulders of the petitioner/applicant for ensuring compliance of the award dated 22.03.2021.
