UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

Yesterday, upon mentioning by the learned  
counsel for the petitioner(s), we passed the  
following order:-

"Learned counsel for the  
petitioners while mentioning has  
referred to a communication from the  
office of the Maharashtra Housing and  
Area Development Authority (MHADA) dated  
01.06.2026. According to which, on  
05.06.2026, the demolition/eviction  
activity is likely to take place. As  
such, urgent mentioning is accepted.

Let the matter be listed tomorrow, i.e. 05.06.2026."

Today, when the case is taken up, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the Enforcement Team along with the local police team/officials have already arrived at the spot, and therefore, the matter be taken up as a first case today, otherwise the petitioner would be evicted and further demolition will take place. Accordingly, the matter has been taken up out of turn.

The order impugned is an order passed by the Bombay High Court, whereby on 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2026, the Division Bench, although issued notices, fixing returnable date of 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2026, but did not pass any interim order in favour of the petitioners.

Considering the nature of request made, we direct that this matter may be listed on 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2026.

Notices may be issued to the respondents, returnable on 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2026.

Dasti service, in addition, is permitted.

Further steps may be taken within three days from today and affidavit of service may be filed on or before the next date fixed i.e. 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2026.

Till the next date of hearing, parties shall maintain *status quo*.
