ORDER

1. Mr. Om Prakash Bhati, Advocate, appears on behalf of the Petitioners, namely Mr. Narendra Surana and Mr. Neeraj Surana.
2. Mr. Amit Pareek, Company Secretary and Learned Authorized Representative, appears on behalf of Respondent No. 2, Mr. Binod Kumar Surana.
3. Mr. S. Biswas, Company Prosecutor representing the Registrar of Companies (RoC), is present.
4. The remaining Respondents have already been proceeded against ex parte.
5. The present Company Petition has been filed by the Petitioners seeking winding up of the Company.

6. Learned counsel for Respondent No. 2, Mr. Binod Kumar Surana, submits that M/s R.S. Enterprise Pvt. Ltd. is a running concern. Per contra, learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that the Company is not in operation.
7. In view of the dispute regarding the operational status of the Company, this Tribunal deems it appropriate to appoint an Advocate Commissioner to ascertain and verify whether the Company is functioning and carrying on its business activities. Accordingly, with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, Mr. Bishal Agarwal, Advocate, is appointed as Advocate Commissioner for the said purpose.
8. Mr. Bishal Agarwal, Advocate, present in the Court has given his consent to act as Advocate Commissioner.
9. Learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that the Petitioner shall bear the costs of the Advocate Commissioner. The fee of the Advocate Commissioner is fixed at Rs. 25,000/-, (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) which shall be paid by Mr. Narendra Surana.
10. The Advocate Commissioner is directed to conduct the inspection and submit his report before this Tribunal within ten (10) days.
11. List the matter on **15.07.2026** for further consideration.
