**UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R**

1. Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, we are not inclined to entertain the petition. Hence, Special Leave Petition stands dismissed. Petitioner is at liberty to urge all grounds before the disciplinary authority in view of the order of remand passed by the disciplinary authority. Petitioner would also be at liberty to submit a representation to the respondent(s) for considering the prayer for restoration of the pay-scale which

was reduced by the disciplinary authority vide order dated 07.04.2015. The said representation shall be considered by the authority expeditiously and preferably within one month from the date of the submission of the representation. It is needless to state that petitioner – delinquent employee shall fully cooperate with the conduct of the inquiry, if need be on day-to-day basis as may be decided by the Enquiry Officer.
