Medicine (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Post-Graduates Institutions and Minimum Standards for Post-Graduation Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024. Her submission is placed on record.

3. At the request of learned counsel appearing for respondent No.1 - State, two weeks' time is granted finally to file the affidavit in this regard. Respondent No.2 is also at liberty to file its affidavit within an outer limit of two weeks from today.
