1. This is an office reference.
2. As per the PUD attached with the application, the learned Fifth District Judge, Bilaspur, has sent a request letter dated 11.09.2026 seeking an extension of time of two months to decide Civil Suit No.24A/2024 pending before the said Court. It has further been stated that, as per the report received from the officials of the Revenue Department, the demarcation could not be carried out due to the rainy season.
