O R D E R

1. We have perused the affidavit dated 04.05.2026 filed by respondent No.2-Delhi Transport Corporation. We have also examine the service record of the employee.

We direct that as and when all the formalities are completed by the petitioners, the same be released forthwith by the Authorities and not later than four weeks thereafter.

5. The Special Leave Petition is disposed of accordingly.
