O R D E R

1. On 04.05.2026, the following order was passed in the related contempt proceeding

"X... 3) Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that possession of only 184 sq. meters of land could not be delivered. It is submitted that respondent No.1 has even written to the Commissioner of Police, which is not acted upon by the police authorities to comply with the directions of this Court. 4) In view of the aforesaid, we direct the Commissioner of Police, Kolkata, to provide police help for compliance of the order of this Court and report be made available within a month to the Registry of

this Court. 5) The contempt petition is disposed of accordingly. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of..."
