O R D E R

1. IA No. 182947/2026 - for condonation of delay in filing is allowed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) would submit that in a similar Special Leave Petition bearing SLP(C) No. 15804/2026, a Coordinate Bench of this Court has allowed three months time to the respondent(s) to frame a scheme for making payment of the amount as directed by the High Court.
3. Mr. K. Rajeev, learned counsel appearing for the respondent(s) on caveat would submit that the present matter(s) are different inasmuch as in the present cases, the payment is to be made by the Life Insurance Corporation and not by the Bank.
