 - d) *Pass any other order(s) as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit in the interest of justice.*

2. Let notice be issued to the Respondents by the Registry, returnable by next date. The Applicant is also directed to collect the notice from the Registry within three days and serve upon the Respondents along with copy of this order through Registered Ad Post / Speed-post / Dasti Mode as well as on the registered e-mail ID of the Respondents registered with the MCA within seven days.
3. The Respondents are directed to file reply within seven days from the date of receipt of notice. Thereafter, rejoinder, if any, be filed within a period of seven days.
4. Proof of Service be filed by way of an affidavit before the next date of hearing.
5. The company is directed not to carry out Extra Ordinary General Meeting scheduled on 01.06.2026.
6. Re-list for further consideration on 11.06.2026.
