02. 1. This matter is taken up through hybrid mode.
2. Petitioner in this writ petition prays for the following relief:

“Under the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is therefore, prayed that this Hon'ble Court may graciously be pleased to:

(i) allow and admit this Writ Petition and thereby direct/order the Opp. Parties to consider the representation as at Annexure-2 to the Writ Petition and thereby make a One Time Settlement (O.T.S.) of said loan Account for the interest of justice;

(ii) pass such other order(s) or issue direction(s) as may be deemed fit and proper in the bona fide interest of justice;

And for this act of kindness, the petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.”

3. It is submitted by Mr. Pattnaik, learned counsel for the Petitioner that the loan amount has been settled under the One



Time Settlement (OTS) Scheme and he has deposited 50 per cent of the settled amount.

4. Since it is submitted that the matter has already been settled under the OTS Scheme, the prayer made in the writ petition does not survive. If the Petitioner has any further grievances, he may, if so advised, may approach the Bank for redressal of the same.

5. Hence, the writ petition is disposed of without any interference of the Court, but with an observation that the Petitioner, if so advised, may approach the Bank for redressal of the grievances.
