ORDER
(Hybrid Mode)

11.05.2026: I.A No. 2708 of 2026: This is an application praying for condonation of 13 days delay in filing of the appeal. Ld. counsel for the Appellant has referred to paras 2 and 3 of the application and para 6 of the rejoinder where sufficient explanation has been given for condonation of 13 days delay which is which condonable period. The application is allowed. Delay condoned.

Ld. Counsel for the Appellant submits that certified copy of the impugned order has been filed which is taken on record.

Ld. Counsel for the Appellant submits that Respondent No. 1 who has filed section 9 application was neither a partnership firm nor any entity under a statute and was not eligible to file an application under Section 9 being not

covered by definition of “person” in Section 3(23) of the Code. Submission needs scrutiny.

Issue notice. Let the reply be filed within three weeks. Rejoinder, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter. List on 16th July, 2026.

In the meantime, any action in the CIRP shall abide by the result of the appeal.
