IA/1057(AHM)2026 in IA/185(AHM)2025

This Application has been filed by Respondent Nos. 6A and 6B under Rule 11 of the National Company Law Tribunal Rules, 2016 read with Section 60(5) of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016, seeking recall/modification of the order dated 17.06.2026 whereby their right to file a reply in IA/185(AHM)2025 was closed and for taking on record the accompanying reply affidavit.

On advance notice, the learned Proxy Counsel appearing for the Respondent/Liquidator waives formal notice.

It is an admitted position that the reply affidavit was affirmed on 27.06.2026, i.e., after the order dated 17.06.2026 closing the Applicants' right to file a reply. The Respondent/Liquidator shall be at liberty to file a rejoinder, if any, within **two weeks** thereafter.
