1. The present C.M.P. has been filed seeking two weeks more time to remove the surviving defect in W.P.(C) No.2361 of 2021 by suitably modifying the order dated 18th July, 2025 passed in C.M.P. No.609 of 2025.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 18th July, 2025 passed in C.M.P. No.609 of 2025, the petitioner was granted time till 1st August, 2025 to remove the surviving defect in W.P.(C) No.2361 of 2021 by modifying the order dated 18th

November, 2022 passed in C.M.P. No.419 of 2022. It is further submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that due to inadvertence one of the surviving defects could not be noted by him, as a result of which the said defect could not be removed within the extended time granted by this Court i.e. till 1st August, 2025. He further assures this Court that remaining defect would be removed by 7th July, 2026.

3. Considering the said submission of learned counsel for the petitioner, the time earlier granted to the petitioner to remove the surviving defect in W.P.(C) No.2361 of 2021 is extended till 7th July, 2026.
4. It is made clear that no further opportunity will be granted to the counsel for the petitioner to remove the surviving defect in W.P.(C) No.2361 of 2021.
5. The order dated 18th July, 2025 passed in C.M.P. No.609 of 2025 is modified to the said extent.
6. The present C.M.P. is disposed of.
