O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. Having considered the matter in its entirety, we do not find any reason to interfere in the impugned order passed by the High Court. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition stands dismissed.

3. However, before parting, we observe in categorical terms that dismissal of the present petition should not be taken as validation of the stand taken by the respondent no.1 before the Court, which persuaded grant of anticipatory bail to him. We also make it clear that in future, if there is any violation or transgression by the respondent no.1 with regard to any conduct *vis-a-viz*, the petitioner, the same shall give a fresh cause of action to the petitioner to move before the appropriate forum, in accordance with law and the same shall be considered on its own merits without being prejudiced by the present order.

4. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
