UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Sharanagouda Patil, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.
2. There is a delay of 2165 days in filing the present petition.

3. However, learned counsel contends that SLP (Civil) No.23274 of 2023 (*Suresh Pandappa Lingareddi & Anr. v. Karnataka Neravari Nigam Ltd. & Anr.*) which arises out of the relied upon judgment, is pending in this Court and the following order has been passed on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2023:

"1. Delay condoned.

2. However, it is made clear that the petitioners would not be entitled for any interest for the period of delay, in the event the petitioners succeed in the present petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners relies on the judgment in MFA No.100095/2016, wherein on the concession of the authority, the High Court has awarded concession of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lacs only) per acre.

4. In that view of the matter, issue notice."

4. In view of above, delay condoned.

5. Issue notice.

6. It is made clear that in the event of the petitioners succeeding in the present petition, the petitioners shall not be entitled to any interest for the period of delay.

7. To be heard along with SLP (Civil) No.23274 of 2023.
