UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. In our order dated 03.06.2026, it was recorded that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of ₹35,000,000/- (Rupees Thirty-Five Lakhs Only) to demonstrate her bona fide for endeavoring to enter into a settlement with the respondent,

on such terms as may be agreed upon between them.

2. It is submitted that the petitioner has deposited a sum of ₹35,000,000/- with the Registry on 04.07.2026, which has been invested in a Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR).

3. Mrs. Vaijayanthi Girish, learned counsel appearing for the sole respondent has no objection to making an endeavor for a mediated settlement.

4. In view of the above, the parties are referred to mediation to be conducted by the Supreme Court Mediation Centre. For this purpose, the parties shall appear virtually before the mediator appointed by the Supreme Court Mediation Centre on 03.08.2026 at 11:00 AM, and thereafter, appear either virtually or physically as directed by the mediator.

5. List this matter on 02.11.2026 for submission of the Mediator's Report.

6. The Registry shall look into the typographical error in the Office Report showing the date of maturity of the FDR as 16.01.2026 and rectify the same.

7. The interim order passed earlier shall continue till the next date of hearing.
