This is an application filed by the applicant under Section 60(5) of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 read with Rule 11 of the National Company Law Tribunal Rules, 2016, with the following prayers:

- A. *Direct the Respondent to forthwith provide to the Applicant complete copies of all warranty certificates, warranty terms and conditions, warranty booklets, and all related documentation pertaining to each of the Tata EVs owned by the Corporate Debtor;*
- B. *Direct the Respondent to honour the warranty coverage for the batteries, drivetrain, and all other components of such Tata EVs and to treat the said warranties as valid and subsisting;*
- C. *Direct the Respondent to fully, promptly, and continuously cooperate with the Applicant in all matters relating to the maintenance and servicing in terms of the extant warranty of such Tata EVs;*
- D. *Pass any other order(s) or direction(s) as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice, equity, and successful completion of the CIRP Process.*

Ld. Counsel for the Applicant/RP undertakes to file amended cause title within a period of two days.

Thereafter, notice be issued to the Respondents by the Registry, returnable by next date. The Applicant is directed to collect the notice from the Registry within three days and serve upon the Respondents along with copy of this order through Registered Ad post / Speed-post, Dasti mode as well as on the registered email ID of the Respondents within seven days.

The Respondents are directed to file reply within seven days from the date of receipt of notice. Rejoinder, if any, be filed before the next date of hearing.

Proof of Service be filed by way of an affidavit before the next date of hearing.
