A W A R D

1. Heard Mr. Ashwin V. Kotemath, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Ms. Sakshi Mittal, learned counsel appearing for the respondent no.1 -Insurance Company assisted by Mr. Akarsh Deepak, Deputy Manager of Oriental Insurance Co. Ltd.
2. We have interacted with learned counsel representing the respective parties. The Motor Accident Claims Tribunal (MACT) had awarded compensation of Rs 40,87,000/- (Rupees Forty Lakh

Eight Seven Thousand) along with interest @ 9% which was reduced to Rs 30,23,484/- (Rupees Thirty Lakh Twenty Three Thousand Four Hundred and Eighty Four) along with interest @ 7.5% by the High Court.

3. After some negotiations, the parties have arrived at full and final settlement, as per which, petitioners has agreed to receive a consolidated amount of Rs 16,00,000/- (Rupees Sixteen lakh). This amount shall be in addition to the amount already determined by the High Court as referred above. The amount shall be paid within a period of six weeks from today.

4. In view of the above settlement, the Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of.
