ORDER

The present Appeal has been filed under Rule 63 of the NCLT Rules, 2016 seeking direction to file the complete petition in 3 volumes (including the missing Volume-III containing the Checklist) under Diary No. 0404116012252026. Condone the procedural defect and direct the Registry to accept the re-filed Petition and process the same in accordance with law.

Heard Mr. Nikhil Kumar Verma, Learned Counsel for the Appellant who submitted that due to technical glitch in the e-filing portal Volume III could not be successfully uploaded on 07.06.2026. Consequently Volumes I and II were uploaded and Volume III remained missing. As per defect raised on 09.06.2026 the Volume III is missing only Volume I and II uploaded. Being aggrieved by the

order of the Ld. Registrar dated 09.06.2026, Appellant filed the appeal with request to file the complete petition in proper form immediately after opening the portal.

Mr. Nikhil Kumar Verma, Learned Counsel for the Appellant sought two days time to refile the main petition along with complete set.

Upon considering the submission made by the learned Counsel appearing for the Appellant the appeal is allowed and appellant is directed to remove its defects within two days and Registry is directed to open the portal so that learned Counsel for the Applicant will be able to remove the defects.

Accordingly, the present Appeal bearing **Appeal No.13/Chd/Hry/2026** stands ***allowed and disposed of.***
