Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("SEBI LODR Regulations") read with Part B of Schedule III thereto, the SEBI Circulars relating to compliance with the SEBI LODR Regulations and the applicable Industry Standards on disclosure of material events, we hereby inform you that the Company has received the Judgement passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh in connection with a litigation involving the Company.

Som Distilleries & Breweries Limited ("SDBL" or the "Company") is pleased to inform that the Hon'ble High Court of Madhya Pradesh, vide its judgment dated September 24, 2026, has quashed the order dated June 18, 2026 rejecting the Company's applications for renewal of its excise licences.

The Hon'ble Court has directed renewal of all the Company's manufacturing licences under the applicable provisions of the Madhya Pradesh Excise Act within 15 days from the order date. The order marks an important step towards the resumption and normalization of the Company's operations in Madhya Pradesh.

The Hon'ble High Court has also awarded costs of ₹1 lakh payable to us by the Government of Madhya Pradesh.

The Hon'ble Court has also ordered and preserved the Company's right to pursue damages/losses arising from the period of operational closure before an appropriate forum. The judgment has thereby vindicated the Company's stand throughout the period and demonstrates that there was no compromise on our corporate governance, ethical standards or commitment to lawful conduct. The Company consistently acted to protect its legitimate interests and safeguard the interests of all its stakeholders.

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The Company welcomes the clarity provided by the judgment on the renewal of its key excise licences. The renewal of these licences is an important step towards restoring normal operations at its Madhya Pradesh facilities and strengthening the Company's ability to serve its markets.

The Company remains focused on:

1. restoration and normalisation of operations;
2. efficient utilisation of its manufacturing capacities;
3. strengthening its product portfolio and distribution network;
4. improving working-capital efficiency;
5. serving consumers and business partners across its markets; and
6. creating sustainable long-term value for all stakeholders.

The Company will work closely with the relevant authorities to complete the renewal process within the timeframe directed by the Hon'ble Court.

We remain firmly committed to conducting our business in accordance with all applicable legal and regulatory requirements.
