ORDER

1. This is a report filed by the RP under Section 99 of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016.
2. The Learned Counsel for the RP admits that copies of the report have not been served upon the Financial Creditor (FC) and the Personal Guarantor (PG) in terms of Section 99(10) of the Code.
3. As per the Rules/Regulations, under the IBC before any application or report is actually listed for hearing, the same should comply with the provisions of law and the Registry has to ensure the compliance before the matter is numbered and listed.
4. Let a copy of the order be sent to the Registrar, NCLT, New Delhi, to ensure that the preconditions, Rules/Regulations are complied with before applications/reports are numbered and are deemed ready for listing.
5. However, in the interest of justice and to avoid further delay in the matter, notice be issued to the Financial Creditor and the Personal Guarantor. The RP is directed to take steps within 10 days by all prescribed modes for service of notice along with a copy of the report and supporting documents, if any, upon the Financial Creditor and the Personal Guarantor. Affidavit of service be filed a week before the next date of hearing.
