2. It has been agreed that there is now a settlement between the petitioner and the respondent no. 2-Insurance Company that over

and above the amount which has been granted by the High Court being Rs. 40,47,982/- (Rupees Forty Lakh Forty Seven Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight Two), the respondent no. 2 is willing to pay lumpsum amount of Rs. 9,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakh) more. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner after instructions submits that his client is agreeable to take the amount as full and final and final settlement against all his claims that exist between the parties. The settlement is recorded. The amount shall be paid within a period of six weeks from today.

3. In view of the above settlement, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.
