ORDER

1. The Learned Counsel on behalf of the Operational Creditor is present sought time to file rejoinder and submitted that vide order dated 15.04.2026, three weeks' time was given to them for filing Rejoinder to the Reply filed by the Corporate Debtor and four weeks' time was given to the Corporate Debtor to file their reply.
2. The Learned Counsel submitted that the Corporate Debtor has filed their reply on 25.05.2026 and therefore as per the previous order, they are entitled to file rejoinder in 3 weeks by the date.

3. Attention is invited to the parties towards amendment made in the IBC, wherein, specific timeline of 14 days is given for deciding Section 9 Petition, failing which reasons has to be recorded in the order. Since time for rejoinder has already been granted, last opportunity of 10 days to the Operational Creditor to file their rejoinder.
4. The Learned Counsel on behalf of the Corporate Debtor present and submitted that the arguing counsel is not available today.
5. List this matter for final arguments on **14.07.2026**. It is made clear that no further adjournment can be granted. The matter need not be listed on 03.07.2026 in terms of order dated 25.05.2026.
