O R D E R

We have heard Mr. Amrendra Kumar Mehta, learned counsel for the petitioner and Ms. Nidhi Jaswal for respondent no.1 in SLP (C) No.12006/2025.

We are of the view that the matters can be disposed of in terms of the order passed by this Court on 28.03.2025, whereby it was made clear that

withdrawal of 50% of the amount shall be allowed only if the respondents furnish bank guarantee of a nationalized bank for the said amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Court. Insofar as the balance amount is concerned, the High Court has already made clear that it shall be kept in a fixed deposit so that it earns a maximum interest. The same may be kept in a nationalized bank.

In view of the above, we are of the opinion that the these matters can be disposed of to enable the High Court to hear and decide the matter finally. We order accordingly.
