Issue a suitable writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari calling the record of the case and quash the impugned show cause notice dated 11-03-2024 Ref No. ZD0503240063330 (Annexure No. 3 to W.P) (Page No 20 to 25).</i> <i>b. Issue a suitable writ, order or direction in the nature of certiorari calling the record of the case and quash the impugned adjudication order dated 16-08-2024 Ref No. ZD050824010164T (Annexure No. 4 to W.P)) (Page No 26 to 33) as petitioner is ready for the fresh proceedings of the case.”</i> 4. According to the petitioner, the impugned order was passed in absolute disregard of principles of natural justice, as notice was not duly served upon the petitioner personally. 5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits



			that an identical question came up before the Coordinate Bench in Writ Petition (MB) No. 1065 of 2025. 6. This submission is not seriously disputed by Ms. Puja Banga, learned State Counsel. 7.
