UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. Mukul Rohatgi, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner.

2. The grievance of the petitioner is that even though the petitioner was identically situated with the petitioners in CM-516-CWP-2026 in CWP-39149-2025 (*Mohinder Pal and Others v. State of Punjab and others*)

and CWP-1516-2026 (*The Elysium Group v. State of Punjab & Ors.*), in the petitioner's case after ordering no coercive steps, a further direction has been made that installments due under the allotment letter shall be deposited as per the schedule. We grant liberty to the petitioner to file an appropriate application for modification before the High Court after pointing out the two orders in the identical matters referred to above.

3. In the event of any adverse order being passed, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file Special Leave Petition against the present impugned order also.

4. The Special Leave Petition is disposed of in the above terms.

5. Pending applications shall also stand disposed of.
