**ORDER**

1. The appellant had filed an application dated April 30, 2026 received by SEBI through RTI MIS portal) under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (“**RTI Act**”). The respondent, by a letter dated May 26, 2026 responded to the application filed by the appellant. The appellant filed an appeal dated May 28, 2026 (Reg. No. SEBIH/A/E/26/00201). I have perused the application, the response of the respondent and the appeal and find that the matter can be decided based on the material available on record.
2. The appellant has filed the appeal only against the response of the respondent to query nos. 2 and 3 in the application.
3. **Query nos. 2 and 3 in the application** - The appellant, vide query nos. 2 and 3 in his application dated 30/04/2026 sought the following information:

*“2. Please provide details of the Appellate Authority and/or Adjudicating Officer within SEBI to be approached in cases involving irregularities or grievances related to BRSR reporting.*

*3) Kindly include the official contact details (such as designation, office address, email ID, and phone number) of the above-mentioned authorities.”*

4. **Reply of the Respondent** – The respondent, in response to query nos. 2 and 3 in the application, informed that the queries are not clear and specific and are in the nature of seeking clarification/opinion. Accordingly, the same cannot be construed as “information” as defined under section 2(f) of RTI Act. Notwithstanding

the aforesaid, the respondent informed that the appointment of an Adjudicating Officer takes place only when relevant enforcement actions are initiated, upon conclusion of examination of a matter.

5. **Ground of appeal** – The appellant has filed the appeal on the ground that he was provided incomplete, misleading or false information.
6. I have perused the queries and the response provided thereto. On consideration, I find that the appellant's queries are in the nature of seeking clarification/opinion from the respondent. I find that the said queries cannot be construed as seeking 'information' as defined under section 2(f) of the RTI Act. Consequently, the respondent did not have an obligation to provide such clarification or confirmation under the RTI Act. In this context, reliance is placed on matter of *Azad Singh vs. CPIO, Oriental Insurance Company Limited* (order dated March 23, 2021) wherein Hon'ble Central Information Commission(CIC) observed that “7. *The Commission, after hearing the submissions of both the parties and after perusal of records, observed that some queries of the appellant are in the nature of seeking explanation/opinion/advice/confirmation/clarification from the CPIO and he has expected that the CPIO firstly should analyze the documents and then provide information to the appellant. But the CPIO is not supposed to create information; or to interpret information; or to compile information as per the desire of the appellant under the ambit of the RTI Act. As per Section 2(f) of the RTI Act, the reasons/opinions/advices can only be provided to the applicants if it is available on record of the public authority. The CPIO cannot create information in the manner as sought by the appellant. The CPIO is only a communicator of information based on the records held in the office and hence, he cannot be expected to do research work to deduce anything from the material therein and then supply it to him.*” Accordingly, I do not find any deficiency in the response of the respondent.
7. Notwithstanding the aforesaid, the respondent has provided appropriate guidance to the appellant.
8. In view of the above observations, I find that there is no need to interfere with the decision of the respondent. The appeal is accordingly dismissed.
