Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for setting aside the letter dated 02.11.2016 (Annexure P-6), issued by the Chief Area Manager, Indian Oil Corporation, Jalandhar, whereby LPG Distributorship for location Tarn Taran-2 (OBC Category) of the petitioner has been cancelled.

2. Apparently, the present writ petition has been filed after a gap of more than nine years from the date of issuance of letter dated 02.11.2016 (Annexure P-6).

3. A perusal of the order sheets would reveal that the matter has been repeatedly adjourned at the request of learned counsel for the

petitioner. Today despite the second call, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant matter any further.
