Ld. Counsel for the Liquidator submits that SCC has recommended the Scheme to be placed before the Tribunal. Even though the Scheme was filed beyond the timelines prescribed under Regulation 2B of Liquidation Process Regulations, these timelines are directory in nature. The Scheme Proponent has offered a sum of Rs.15 cores and has deposited the EMD amount.

At this juncture, Mr. Akhil Bhansali, Ld. Counsel for the suspended Director stated that a Scheme Proponent who had earlier offered a scheme for Rs.25 crores is still interested in giving the Scheme. When the details of the scheme proponent were sought, Mr. Keshav Kantamneni, suspended director appeared in VC and submitted that the Scheme Proponent's name is RINI Enterprises Ltd.

Liquidator submitted that RINI Enterprises Ltd had submitted a Resolution Plan and as further details were not furnished, the Resolution Plan could not be taken up and the EMD deposit was forfeited. Liquidator further stated that due to the above fact, RINI Enterprises Ltd is not eligible to submit a Scheme.
