O R D E R

While entertaining the present petition *vide*
order dated 17.07.2023, this Court had issued
notice to respondent no. 3 and further directed
that, till further orders, operation of the

impugned order dated 19.06.2023 passed by the High Court directing the petitioner to deposit a sum of Rs. 100 crores in the Registry of the High Court, shall remain stayed. The said interim order has continued till date.

Today, Mr. D.N. Goburdhun, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the present petition may be disposed of by making the interim order absolute, as the High Court is already monitoring the *Suo Motu* Writ Petition registered before the Circuit Bench at Port Blair.

Despite service of notice, none appears on behalf of the respondent(s).

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and submissions advanced, the present petition is disposed of by making the interim order dated 17.07.2023 absolute till disposal of the pending *Suo Motu* Writ Petition before the High Court.

The High Court shall proceed with the matter and decide the same on its merits.
