Heard Learned Counsel for the Applicant/Appellant, who, while drawing our attention towards the contentions of the aforesaid correction/amendment application, submitted that, inadvertently, while filing the appeal, the name of the Respondent, i.e., United Petrofer Ltd., was wrongly typed/written as Universal Petrofer Ltd., and the same requires correction.

We notice that in the impugned order, the name of the Respondent has been written as United Petrofer Ltd.. Thus, it appears that, due to typographical error, the correct name of the Respondent has not been transcribed in the Memo of Appeal.

In view of above, the correction/amendment application moved by the Appellant is allowed. The Appellant is directed to file an amended Memo of Parties within three days from today and also to correct/amend the Memo of Parties in the appeal paper book.

The Registry is also directed to correct the nomenclature of the appeal in its records accordingly.

Since the name of the Respondent has now changed, we permit the Appellant to take fresh steps to serve the Respondent, along with the requisites, within three days from today by Registered Post and E-mail.

No need to say that the Appellant would file an affidavit of service on or before the next date of listing.

List the matter on the date already fixed in the appeal i.e., **15-07-2026.**
