UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. Delay condoned.
3. Applications seeking exemption from filing certified copy of the impugned judgment and official translation are allowed.
4. Petitioner is aggrieved by the following condition imposed by the High Court of Punjab & Haryana at

Chandigarh in the impugned order dated 11.11.2025:

*“The vehicle in question is ordered to be released on furnishing of personal surety bond in the sum of Rs.1 lakh by the petitioner. All other conditions shall remain same.”*

5. We find that the petitioner is the subsequent purchaser, which was purchased from the earlier purchaser, M/s ANI Technologies Pvt. Ltd. (OLA), in the year 2023 through a public auction. It is alleged that the vehicle in question was involved in a crime.

6. In such circumstances, the High Court has modified the order of the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Rewari directing furnishing of Superdginama in the sum of Rs.4 lakhs, to the extent to furnishing of personal surety bond of Rs.1 lakh.

7. We do not find any good reason to interfere with the order passed by the High Court.

8. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition is dismissed.

9. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
