4. This writ petition seeks expeditious disposal of an application under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 pending before the learned District Magistrate at Purba Medinipur.
5. Learned advocate appearing for the Bank submits that the aforesaid application has been pending before the District Magistrate since April 30, 2025.
6. Having heard the learned advocates appearing for the petitioner and the State and having considered the material on record, this writ petition is disposed of by directing the learned District Magistrate,
