UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We have heard Mr. Guru Krishna Kumar, Mr. Sajan Poovayya, learned Senior Counsels for the petitioner(s), Mr.P.S.Patwalia, Mr. Siddharth Aggarwal, Ms. Swathi Sukumar, learned Senior Counsels for the respondents.
2. The impugned judgment is a judgment of reversal. The plaintiff(s) is in appeal before us. The plaintiff's case is that the *patent* in question is a Standard Essential Patents (SEP) and that the plaintiff(s) was prepared to license under the *Fair, Reasonable, and Non-Discriminatory - 'FRAND'* terms to the respondent(s).
3. However, according to the plaintiff(s), the defendant(s) refused the '*FRAND*' arrangement. According to the plaintiff(s), there was infringement of the patent.
4. All this is disputed by the defendant(s). The defendant(s) have raised multifarious defences to contend that the patent is not a Standard Essential Patents (SEP); that there was no infringement and they have also relied on the principle of exhaustion to contend that the suit and the reliefs claimed are not maintainable.
5. Having considered the matter(s) and the arguments, we are

of opinion that the matters requires a detailed consideration.

6. Issue notice to the respondent(s), returnable on 11th August, 2026.

7. Let pleadings be completed.

8. In the meantime, the arrangement that prevailed before the Division Bench of the High Court for the past 08 years, namely, 'that the petitioner(s) would keep the *Bank Guarantee* alive' shall continue.

9. We direct that the petitioner(s), till further orders, shall keep the *Bank Guarantee* alive.

10. Mr. Guru Krishna Kumar, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner(s) undertakes, in the event of the impugned orders being sustained and the petitioner(s) losing the appeal(s), they will reimburse the respondent(s) with the upto date amount.

11. Necessary undertaking in this regard be filed within a period of one week from today.

12. Further proceedings, in the High Court for restitution to remain stayed.

13. List the matters on 11th August, 2026.
