O R D E R

1. Having heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and having gone through the materials on record, we are of the view that no error, not to speak of any error of law could be said to have been committed by the High Court in passing the impugned order.

2. The High Court in its impugned order has made itself very clear that it shall be open for the petitioner to challenge the assessment order dated 27.03.2026 by preferring a statutory appeal.

3. The impugned order passed by the High Court is of 07.04.2026. We grant further four weeks' time to the petitioner to prefer the appeal in accordance with law.

4. With the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

5. It shall be open for the petitioner to raise all contentions available to him in law including the contention that the notices issued were statutorily time barred.
