01. 1. This writ application has been filed challenging the order dated 12.05.2026 passed in O.A. No. 236 of 2026 along with M.A. No. 244 of 2026 whereby the learned Central Administrative Tribunal, Cuttack (in short “CAT”) issued notice to the Opposite Parties and posted the matter to 23.07.2026 stating that prayer for grant of interim relief will be considered after filing of reply.
2. Mr. Bibekananda Nayak, learned counsel for the Petitioners submits that if the I.A. for interim order is not considered at an early date, the O.A. will be rendered infructuous.
3. It has been submitted by both the learned counsel that a Vacation Bench of the Tribunal is functioning during this Summer Vacation.
4. In view of the nature of grievance of the Petitioner and after hearing Mr. Bibekananda Nayak, learned counsel for the Petitioners and Mr. P.K. Parhi, learned Deputy Solicitor General of India, we dispose of the writ application, permitting the



Petitioners to move the Vacation Bench of CAT, Cuttack by filing/moving an application seeking appropriate interim relief.

5. If any such motion is made, the same shall be considered by the Vacation Bench of the CAT in accordance with law.

6. The Writ Application along with the I.A. are disposed of with the aforesaid directions.

7. Urgent certified copy of this order be granted on proper application.
