Heard Mr. N. C. Das, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Ms. G. Baishya, learned counsel for the applicant.

2. Mr. Das, learned Senior Counsel submits that after effecting service of notice upon the respondent/opposite party No. 1 by dasti mode, an affidavit has been filed. But the opposite party No. 1 remained unrepresented today.

3. However, Mr. Das, referring to page No. 25 of the additional affidavit submits that

in the meantime, the respondent/opposite party No. 1 has deposited a sum of Rs. 18,90,511/-, being the compensation amount, before the Registry of this Court and since the amount has been deposited by the respondent/opposite party No. 1, this interlocutory application may be closed, by directing the Registry of this Court to release the aforesaid amount in favour of the applicant, after proper identification.

4. Accordingly, taking note of the submission of the learned counsel for the applicant, this Court is inclined to dispose of this interlocutory application, by directing the Registry of this Court to release the amount of Rs. 18,90,511/- in favour of the applicant, after proper identification; within a period of 1 (one) week from today.

5. In terms of the above, this I.A. stands disposed of.
