1. Heard Mr. S.R. Das, learned counsel for the Petitioner and Mr. G. Tripathy, learned AGA for the State-Opposite Parties.

2. It is submitted on behalf of the Petitioner that Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation is proceeding against him for eviction by announcement through loud-speaker without granting any opportunity of hearing.

Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of at the stage of admission with a direction to the Commissioner, Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation, Bhubaneswar (Opposite Party No.4) to grant due opportunity of hearing to the Petitioner and take a decision, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with a copy of the writ petition. Till such decision is taken by Opposite Party No.4, the Petitioner may not be evicted from the case land.
