UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Pursuant to this Court's last order of 25th August, 2026, both Mr. Anil Kumar Sharma, Managing Director of Tenughat Vidyut Nigam Limited (for short, 'TVNL') and Mrs. Champa Sharma, Contractor/Owner, Aryan Enterprises appeared before the Court through video conferencing.
2. We have heard Dr. Shashi Kiran, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, Mr. Dushyant Parashar, learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 and Mr. Prabhat Ranjan, respondent No.2 appearing through video conferencing.
3. Mr. Prabhat Ranjan, respondent No.2 states that he is not in a position to pay amount to the petitioner-Ms. Shusma Dayal.
4. According to learned senior counsel for the petitioner, the arrears alone are to the tune of Rs.36,00,000/- (Rupees thirty six lakhs), apart from the maintenance at the rate of Rs.6,000/- (Rupees six thousand) per month for the petitioner and her daughter.
5. We are of the opinion that to tide over the immediate crisis and pending further monitoring of the matter, the Managing Director of TVNL and Mrs. Champa Sharma, owner of Aryan Enterprises will ensure that every

month, beginning from the first of every month an amount of Rs.8,000/- (Rupees eight thousand) per month, out of the sums payable to Mr. Prabhat Ranjan by Aryan Enterprises will be deducted and paid to the petitioner-Shusma Dayal directly. We will continue to monitor this matter further.

6. List the matter for further consideration on 2nd November, 2026.

7. The account details of the petitioner shall be furnished to both the Managing Director of TVNL and Mrs. Champa Sharma, owner of Aryan Enterprises and beginning from September, 2026 the amount will be deposited directly to the petitioner.

8. We make it clear that the first deposit into the account of the petitioner would be made either today or tomorrow without fail.
