2. It is noted that vide order dated 21.04.2026, in paragraph 6, directions were issued to the respondents to file a limited reply as regards interim relief. Learned counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Short reply on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 with regard to the interim relief has

been filed on 27.04.2026, and the rejoinder has also been filed on 05.05.2026, as stated by the learned counsel for the petitioners. However, learned counsel for the respondents is also directed to file a detailed reply to the main petition. Learned Senior Counsel for the respondents seeks one week's time to file the detailed reply to the main petition. Time is granted.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioners are not allowed to enter into the company. At this learned counsel for the respondent stated that they are most welcome to enter into the premises and they will be given the access to the records. Learned counsel for the petitioner further stated that they should be directed to provide access to the accounts of the company as they want. We direct that the applicant/petitioner shall be permitted to have full inspection of the financial records.
