A W A R D

1. Heard Mr. Shivam Parasher, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and Mr. Lalit Chauhan, learned counsel appearing for the United India Insurance Company Limited.

2. During the hearing before us, the parties have arrived at a consensus. The Insurance Company would pay a further consolidated amount of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Only) over and above the amount as ordered by the High Court in full and final settlement to the petitioners. The petitioner No.5 is reported to be dead and, therefore, petitioner Nos.1 to 4 are the only surviving legal representatives. Learned counsel appearing for petitioner Nos.1 to 4 submits that on receipt of the consolidated amount of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) over and above the amount awarded by the High Court, they will have no further claim against the Insurance Company.

3. The petitioners shall furnish the account details to the Insurance Company. On due verification, the consolidated amount of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh only) shall be transferred to the petitioner Nos.1 to 4 within a period of six weeks from today.

4. The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
