A W A R D

1. The claimant Akash Choudhary's petition was dismissed by the Tribunal against which an appeal was preferred before the High Court of Bombay at

Goa. The High Court vide award dated 21.03.2024 awarded Rs.38.50 lakhs with interest at the rate of 6% from the date of claim petition till actual payment. Additionally, first respondent before the High Court, namely, Suman Bagari, was directed to pay Rs.25,000/- by way of cost to the claimant. Aggrieved by the order of the High Court, three petitions were filed before this Court.

2. During pendency of these three petitions, parties have entered into a settlement. Two settlement deeds have been presented before us along with office report dated 21.08.2026. As per the settlement, Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company Limited has agreed to pay claimant - Akash Choudhary a sum of Rs.54 lakhs as full and final settlement of all claims. Akash Choudhary in turn has waived his claim of cost of Rs.25,000/- imposed on Suman Bagari.
3. In view of the above, these three petitions stand disposed of in terms of the settlement(s) dated 22.07.2026. The settlement(s) shall be made part of the Award(s).
