1. Hon'ble Mr. Justice Pamidighantam Sri Narasimha pronounced the judgment of the Bench comprising His Lordship and Hon'ble Mr. Justice Alok Aradhe.

2. Delay condoned.
3. Leave granted.
4. The appeal stands allowed in terms of the signed reportable judgment. Paragraph nos. 61 and 62 of the Judgment read as under:-

"61. For the reasons stated above, we allow the appeal, set aside the judgment and order passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad. We declare that inclusion of appellant's name in Caution List is impermissible and without jurisdiction. There shall be a consequential direction to the respondents to remove the name of the appellant from the Caution List with immediate effect.

62. List the appeal on 31.08.2026 for considering the issues relating to institutionalising Continuing Legal Education (CLE) and the proposal for establishing National Legal Academy (NLA). BCI may file an affidavit indicating the developments a week before the listing of the case."
