UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Permission to file Special Leave Petitions is granted.
2. Petitioner would call in question the order passed by the High Court allowing the writ petition preferred by the respective writ petitioners directing the refund of the amount wrongly recovered from the writ petitioners as additional premium. While delivering the judgment, the High Court has referred to its earlier decision on similar issue in the matter of *Raghuleela Builders Private Limited and Anr. vs. Mumbai Metropolitan Region Development Authority (MMRDA) & Ors.*¹ (“Raghuleela Builders Private Limited”). Admittedly, the Special Leave Petition against the order passed by the High Court in *Raghuleela Builders Private Limited* has been dismissed by this Court in SLP (C) No. 6411/2020 by order dated 27.07.2020.
3. Upon examining the materials placed before us, we are not inclined to entertain these Special Leave Petitions on merits as well as for the reason that the identical issue having been decided by the High Court in *Raghuleela Builders Private Limited* has already been affirmed by this Court in SLP (C) No. 6411/2020.
4. The Special Leave Petitions are, accordingly, dismissed.
5. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
